OUR PRACTICE

Scripture is the primary source for worship and theology.

In worship design, the fourfold order of worship is employed:

- Gathering the people to honour God the Three in One.
- Proclaiming the Word
- Responding to the Word, and
- **Sending** the people.

Because culture is innate in worship, the Nairobi
Statement of Worship and Culture is an important reference.

exploring the psalms as a rich resource for prayers and songs is a continuous and much-needed process.

Expressions of worship are manifested through prayers, music and arts of diverse language, culture, tradition, and style.

We sing from a broad music repertoire with texts that include creation, environment, social justice, unity, amongst others.

We embrace traditional, contemporary, and blended worship practices.

We advocate stewardship of Godgiven gifts of music and arts in each culture.

These gifts are explored and studied so that we discover how they may be used creatively in worship.

The liturgical year

is observed thoughtfully. It is used to narrate and re-tell the life of Christ in worship. "(It) is the arena where our life and the life of Jesus intersect" (Joan Chittister).

OUR LOGO

THE CROSS

symbolises who we worship, as well as God's story of redemption and restoration, which we remember, celebrate, and re-enact in worship.



THE CIRCLE

symbolises the congregation - all who are worshippers of Jesus Christ.

THE 3 STROKES

have several layers of meaning:

- each stroke represents those who are called to the worship ministry; and there are 3 because we aspire to equip and nurture all those in the worship ministry with the (1) knowledge, (2) skill, and (3) character their service requires
- one end of each stroke points toward the cross as those in the worship ministry can only serve by depending on and imitating Christ
- the other end of each stroke points toward the circle, because as worship servants, we seek to love and serve the congregation
- orange is a reference to the Holy Spirit working through those in the worship ministry

OUR HERITAGE

THE METHODIST APPROACH

John Wesley, the founder of the Methodist movement, was well-known for his teaching on **social holiness**, as well as a method of theological reflection known as the **Wesleyan Quadrilateral**.

To be socially holy is to discover the justice and compassion of God...We cannot rest in private heavens while there is suffering and need all around us.

Bishop Emeritus Dr Robert Solomon on social holiness Bishop Emeritus Dr Robert
Solomon writes: "The root of
social holiness is lies in God's
love for His creation. He cares
for the poor, the orphans and
the widows (Jam. 1:27). When
we relate to God with
personal piety and devotion,
we will discover that we
cannot love God without also
loving others (1 Jn. 4:20-21).
Our vertical devotions lead to
horizontal duties."

Hence at MSM, we approach worship with social holiness at the forefront of our minds. Worship services must be designed, and worship leaders must lead, in a manner that forms the congregation into greater Christ-likeness, so that they can be sent out into the world to love their neighbour.

The Wesleyan Quadrilateral is a term used to describe he principal factors that John Wesley believed illuminate the core of the Christian faith for the believer. The four sides of the quadrilateral are: (1) Scripture, (2) tradition,

(3) reason, and (4) experience.

Scripture is the primary source and standard for Christian doctrine.

Tradition is the witness of development and growth of the faith through the past centuries in many nations and cultures.

Experience is the individual's understanding and appropriating of the faith in the light of his or her own life. Through reason the individual Christian brings to bear on the Christian faith discerning and cogent thought.

These four elements taken together bring the individual Christian to a mature and fulfilling understanding of the Christian faith and the required response of worship and service.

At MSM, the Wesleyan Quadrilateral illuminates our thinking about worship. In matters of worship, Scripture is primary, but the traditions of Christianity's forefathers merit deeper study too. And finally, through reason and experience, we seek to distil and apply the doctrines and principles gleaned from Scripture and tradition in a manner that is relevant to our context and culture.

FOR WM LEADERS

CERTIFICATE IN CHRISTIAN WORSHIP

A carefully-designed course for leaders in the worship ministry, i.e. worship leaders, choir directors, music directors, worship directors, pastors.

CCW 1: The Essentials of Worship

A 6-module programme designed to equip worship leaders with the essentials of worship. A practicum component is integrated with separate tracks for worship leaders and musicians. Currently available in English and Chinese.

Commitment required: 6 months (Jun-Nov), 1 module (full day, Sat) per month

Pre-requisite: none

CCW 2: Worship Leadership

A 6-module programme that aims to provide a platform for deeper conversations and reflections on: why history and theology matters, recognizing the changing culture and its implication on worship, the discipline of discernment, the voice of the congregation, and the practice of online worship. Currently available in English only.

Commitment required: 6 months (Jun-Nov), 1 module (2.5h) per month Pre-requisite: must have completed CCW 1 / previous runs of CCW (2013-2021)

Frequency: 2 episodes a year, online on Zoom



ELECTRIC GUITAR

For classical pianists who wish to serve on their contemporary worship teams, we can tech you how to play in a modern band.

Workshop Examples

BAND DYNAMICS

From an acoustic setup to a large multi-instrumental group with backing tracks, we can show how to maximize the musical potential of any setup.

UKULELE

Learn the basics of playing the ukulele, including tuning, chord progressions and songform examples, praise & worship songs, etc.

CHILDREN IN WORSHIP

Frequency: once a month, Mar-Nov (currently a pilot project)


